Kykuit: *The Hudson Valley's top cultural attraction!* Kykuit was home to four generations of the Rockefeller family, beginning with the philanthropist John D. Rockefeller, founder of Standard Oil.

Philipsburg Manor: Netherlands-born Frederick Philipse and two partners made the initial purchase of land that had been part of a Dutch patroonship. Philipse subsequently bought his partners out and added more land before being granted a royal charter in 1693 for the 52,000 acres (21,000 ha) estate, becoming its first lord.
